The previous minutes were reviewed and agreed.

1. SB reported that Alastair Strang of Brereton NP was unable to meet with her but did provide some guidance and did produce the NP specific skill requirements and learnings. (circulated at meeting)
2. It was agreed that to move the plan forward we should contact everyone that has volunteered to help, and invite them to a meeting at the Village Hall in September as the present Plan Team do not have the resources without extensive additional help. AR has a list of email addresses in the analysis. JC would contact others by telephone. AJC agreed to draft an email.
3. **Branding.** NS reported on the website. NS would send proposals for branding to Don Muir and ask for templates.
4. **GIS mapping.** NS reported on this. Easy to use system. Costs- licence, training etc. around £1000 over 5 years. Parish Online—same sort of facility. Webservice. Doesn't have to be under control of 1 person. Cost around £56 per year. It was agreed we should ask Cheshire East if we can use their layers eg. Footpath numbers etc.
5. Projector— discussed possibility of asking Parish Council to consider purchasing one, this would assist the NP team particularly with mapping (and would assist Parish Council with Planning Issues.)
